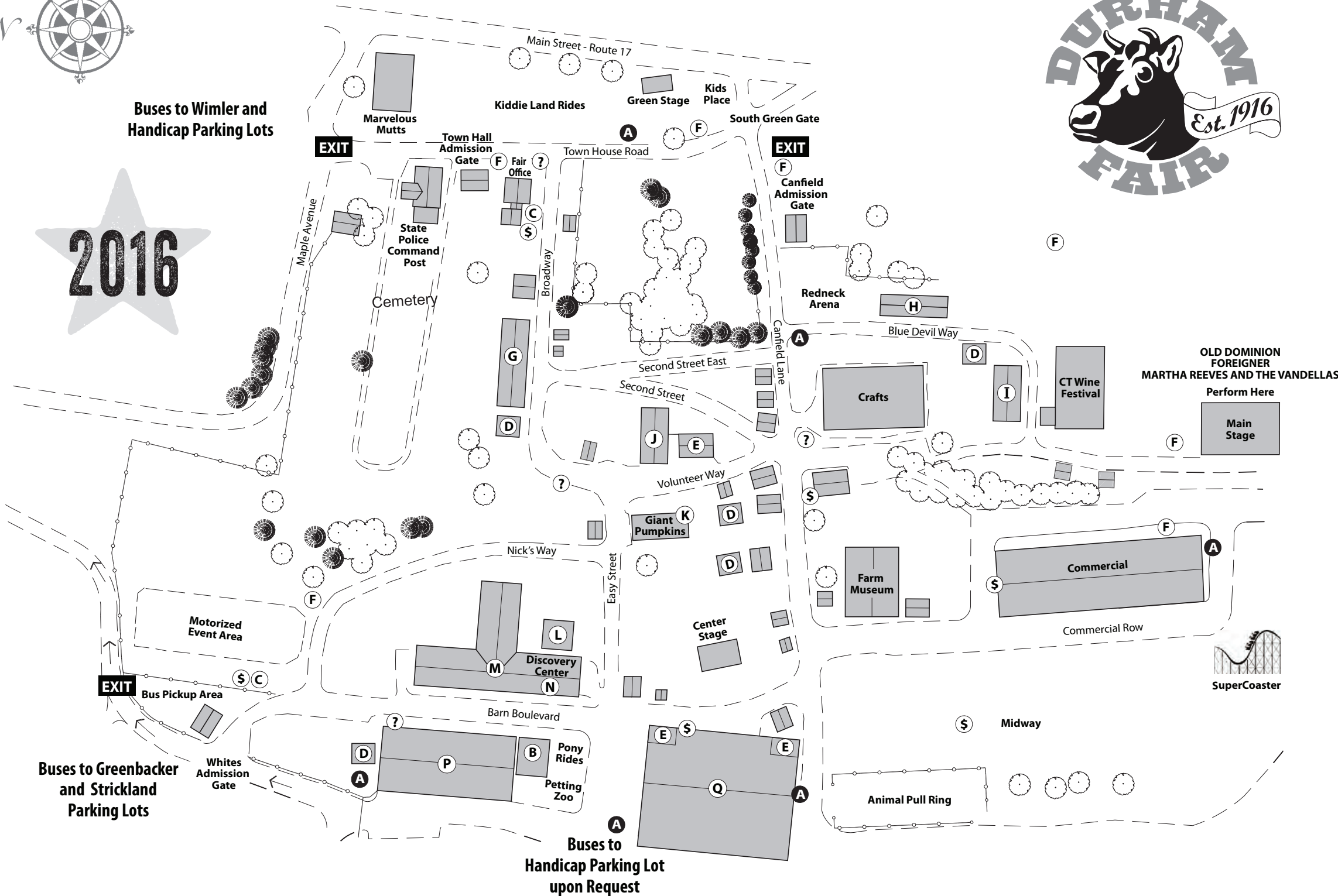

**Art Department**—Solve the mystery! Look for the clues and earn an Art Detective Badge. Visiting Artist Series (see daily schedule).  
**Cow Palace**—Milking Time each day, 4-6 pm.  
**Discovery Center**—Ongoing educational exhibits and demonstrations.  
**Farm Museum**—Ongoing exhibits and demonstrations of early farm life, continuous blacksmith demonstrations. In addition, 3 times daily, pulley-driven antique farm equipment demonstrations, including corn grinders, hay press, lime crusher, corn chopper, wood saw and lungers engine.  
**Fiber Department**—Spinning and weaving demonstrations, along with touch fibers and an educational area for kids—**Llama Barn**.

## Important Notices:
